Exhibit Details and Fees

Exhibit booths consist of one or two six foot table(s) covered and draped. Signs, decorations and equipment may not be placed outside the booth space. Exposed unfinished sides of the exhibit must be draped to present an attractive appearance. Hanging signs are not permitted.

Exhibitors or agents may not attach at any time to any stationary wall, floor, window, columns, furniture or ceiling with screws, nails, staples, tape or any other substance. Nothing can be posted, nailed, screwed or otherwise attached to columns, floors, furniture or other areas of the hotel. Only professionally printed signs will be allowed for the display.

We will do our best to accommodate reasonable displays within the allocated space, in keeping with the display rules and regulations and in consideration of other exhibitors in the same area.

Exhibit Representatives

The authorized exhibit representative shall have the authority to act on behalf of the exhibiting organization in space reservation transactions with the CTOS

& MSTS. To certify that bona fide representatives are operating the exhibit, CTOS & MSTS must receive written notice of change of authorized representative(s) when applicable. All representatives of exhibiting firms must wear the official CTOS/MSTS Exhibitor's badge in the exhibit hall and during any meeting session or event. *Badges are not transferable.*

Representative Fees & Guidelines

Exhibitors will receive two complimentary registrations, which will allow entry to the scientific sessions of the 2011 Combined CTOS / MSTS Meeting with the purchase of one or two six foot table(s). Fees also include all meals and breaks.

You may register additional representatives on the Additional Representative Application section of the form for a fee of \$500 per person.

Exhibits are not required to be staffed during all meeting hours, but should be open to attendees for viewing.

Registration deadline is August 26, 2011.

Space Assignment

Exhibit booth space will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis (for exhibitors not designated as supporters) based upon receipt of exhibit applications and full payment.

Exhibitors will receive notification of booth assignments in writing one month prior to the meeting.

Booth Installation & Dismantle

Shipping Tips

- Multiple packages within a single shipment should be numbered in sequence (e.g. 1 of 3, 2 of 3, etc); it may be helpful to make note of individual package contents so that careful records of all materials may be maintained and the sender alerted in the event of damage or non-receipt.
- Heavy boxes should be identified so that staff (either yours or ours) can avoid injury while lifting them.
- If there is more than one on-site delivery location, please label the boxes with their specific delivery destination (e.g. Office/Parlor A or Registration/Convention Registration Desk).
- Require Exhibitors to ship freight to the designated drayage company, which will deliver boxes to the appropriate exhibit booth.
- The Package Room staff is not allowed on the Exhibition Hall floor for either deliveries or pick-up services.
- Boxes received more than three days prior to the first event will incur a \$25.00 per piece storage fee for each additional day outside of three days.
- The hotel is not responsible for packing any materials. Any packaged materials left behind without shipping instructions will be discarded within three business days.
- If Third party vendors are used for office equipment such as copy machines, computers, fax machines, the hotel cannot be responsible for moving the equipment due to liability. Clients must notify the company of this and ensure the product is picked up prior to the ending time of the contracted meeting space.
